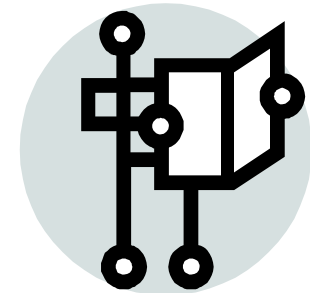

- ❖ Provide high quality instruction that follows the Common Core State Standards (MCCRS) daily and meets the needs of our diverse population.
- ❖ Provide a safe, clean, orderly, and supportive learning environment daily.
- ❖ Meet with each parent/guardian at least once a year for a parent/teacher conference to discuss student progress. Three conference days a year will be made available. The school will make arrangements to accommodate parents' schedules. Teachers will communicate with parents through phone calls, email, or notes. Report cards sent home quarterly.
- ❖ As a school we will provide family night, grade-level night, PTA functions, and parent and grandparent visitation days. Additional volunteer opportunities are SIT committee, parent advisory, and volunteer work (training offered day and night twice a year).
- ❖ Communicate and cooperate with each parent to ensure the best education possible and to reinforce the partnership between parent, student, staff, and community. School wide communication via newsletters and through phone/e-mail using School Messenger. Teachers will be available during daily planning, emails or phone calls to the school to discuss individual matters.
- ❖ Promote the Four Bees of Success: be respectful, be responsible, be ready, and be safe while supporting firm and fair behavior expectations.
- ❖ Provide parents with information to Power School in grades K-5, will send interims home quarterly, provide agenda books in grades 3-5 and take home folders in grades Pre-K-5.
